

## DETAILED ITINERARY

### DAY 1 WELCOME TO BAKU

- Departure from Pakistan
- Pick up from Heydar Aliyev International airport Baku and transfer to Hotel.
- You would be given your room keys.
- Visit National Park and a walk on Baku Boulevard.
- Evening cruise/boat ride in Caspian sea to have a BAKU BY NIGHT View.
- Dinner and relax.

### DAY 2

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Today we shall have BAKU CITY TOUR. Our first stop would be Highland Park which is the highest spot of BAKU from where you will have a Panoramic View of city. The spot will give you the best view over the Baku Bay, National Flag Square and Seaside Boulevard. You will be walking through the Martyrs' Lane to the stairs called "40 Stairs".
- After Highland Park you will drive to the Double Gates to start Old City Walking Tour. "Icherisheher" which is the pearl of Azerbaijani architecture and culture. From Double Gates, starting the tour you will be able to see the Chain, Sailor and Cat Houses, Bukhara and Multani Caravanserais, Jumma Mosque, Maiden Tower. Guide will explain to you the history of the Old City, and its buildings. We shall Proceed to Visit the Miniature Book Museum.
- The most recognizable monument of Old City is Palace of the Shirvanshahs (UNESCO world heritage site), an expansive building that is a testament to Azerbaijan's impressive architectural heritage. Shirvanshahs Palace is the former residence of the rulers of Shrivens and is located in the heart of Baku. In addition to the palace, the amazingly beautiful complex includes the Divan-Khan courtyard, tomb, mosque in 1441, as well as the bathhouse and mausoleum of court scholar Seyyed Yahya Bakuvi.
- Short Break for Lunch at Old City. (Not included in Package)
- After Old City tour, we shall drive to Bibi Heybat Mosque (10 Kilometers – 20 Minutes' drive). The Bibi-Heybat Mosque is a historical mosque in BAKU AZERBAIJAN. The existing structure, built in the 1990s, is a recreation of the mosque with the same name built in the 13th century by Shirvanshahs Farrokhzad II which was completely destroyed in 1936.

The Bibi-Heybat Mosque includes the tomb of Ukeyma Khanum (a descendant of Prophet Mohammad), and today is the spiritual center for the Muslims of the region and one of the major monuments of Islamic architecture in Azerbaijan. It is locally known as "the mosque of Fatima.

- The last destination in the Baku day trip will be the Nizami Street. You will have time to walk to see the beauty of the most central street of the Baku with full of shops and nice restaurants. You will also be able to see the Fountain Square full of magical fountains.
- Dinner at Local restaurant after which you would be free to spend time & Explore Baku night life or get dropped at Hotel by bus.

### DAY 3

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Today we shall Visit Gabala which is almost 3 Hours drive from Baku.

- We shall have our first stop at Sufi Dervish “Diri Baba” Mausoleum where a real miracle happened about a thousand years ago. It is visited not only by tourists, but also by pilgrims, since the mausoleum is an active religious building.
- Our next stop would be Shamakhi, the first capital city of Azerbaijan. You shall visit the Jumma Mosque which is the first mosque of all Caucasus and Azerbaijan. You shall find yourself in the walls of a grandiose architectural structure made according to ancient ant seismic technology. • We shall continue our Journey to Gabala and on the way stop at Honey House.
- Our next stop will be Tufandag resort and cable car. The highest point of this exciting attraction is the peak of the Sleeping Beauty Mountain located at an altitude of about two thousand meters above sea level. You shall have a ride of Cable car for Jaw dropping views of Gabala and surroundings.
- And the nest stop would be Nohur Lake - we shall stop on the shore of a colorful mountain lake and will have a boat ride on its mirrored water surface with the magnificent view of Caucasus Mountains.
- If time permits, we shall visit seven beauties Waterfall on the way back.
- Return Back to BAKU, Dinner at hotel and rest.

#### DAY 4

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Ateshgah Temple– The temple of fire worshippers Ateshgah is located at the Absheron peninsula 30 km from the center of Baku. This territory is known for unique natural phenomenon as burning natural gas outlets (underground gas coming onto surface contacts oxygen and lights up). The temple in its present state was constructed in the 17th-18th centuries. Ateshgah is declared a State historical-architectural reserve of Azerbaijan. This museum under the open sky was recently restored. Different workshops and souvenir galleries are located here now.
- Yanardag (Burning Mountain)- One of the most famous and popular tourist places of the “eternal flame” in Azerbaijan is the mountain of Yanardag. Actually, it is rather a hill than a mountain, with natural gas burning on its slope from ancient times. Yanardag is located 25 km to the north from Baku. From the year 2007 Yanardag is declared a state-protected conservation area.
- LITTLE VENICE - Little Venice is a small town in Baku which was built in 1960. Little Venice is possibly the most romantic part in the city
- Evening dinner and late-night shopping

- Breakfast at hotel.
- Shopping and check out hotel
- Drive to airport to catch your flight
